Regardless of your type of live event—whether a local arts festival in the middle of a field or a concert tour in held in world-class venues—your WiFi requirements are not something you can treat passively if you want to ensure a successful outcome.

Nor can you delegate such an important responsibility and just sit back, hoping that somehow everything will turn out fine. Dependable and faultless high-speed WiFi is now an essential requirement for live events. As a result, it takes careful planning and know-how.




### BECAUSE YOU HAVE A BUSINESS TO RUN, LET'S FIRST ADDRESS PRODUCTION WIFI.

The business end of live events has a few basic but important requirements, including reliable production WiFi and Internet backbone platform. Areas that typically need WiFi and I.T. services include:



- Scanner-controlled ticketing
- Access control platforms
- Point-of-sale (PoS) systems that support cash, credit card and cashless options
- Production staff, including front-of-house (FoH)
   & back-of-house (BoH)
- VIPs WiFi
- Artists
- Exhibitors
- Sponsors
- Emergency services



With the needs of all these stakeholders in mind, there may be significant I.T. requirements to ensure your event runs smoothly.

It's not uncommon to attempt to handle each group's requirements internally. Or, each group might bring in different outside vendors to handle separate needs. However, that's an inefficient approach to managing the I.T. requirements for your live events.


Instead, relying on a single dedicated I.T. vendor to handle all your live event data networking and WiFi will reduce your total I.T. operations cost. You'll also deploy a single, cohesive, powerful and more reliable network. In addition, you'll have network security controls in place so that your live event WiFi networks are distributed to all logistical areas in a proper and secure manner.

### NOW, WHAT ABOUT LIVE EVENT WIFI FOR YOUR EVENT ATTENDEES, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS PUBLIC WIFI?

While there are some extra (incremental) costs for deploying attendee WiFi, it's not as bad as you might think. This is especially true if you already have a full live event WiFi system for your entire production.

- ► Sponsored splash pages with customized branding

- ▶ Ongoing attendee interaction throughout and after the event
- ► Attendee big data analytics and ongoing social media interaction
- **▶** Pre-paid WiFi options
- **▶** On-the-fly paid WiFi options
